Clear Lake is a growing rural community located in Northwestern Wisconsin. Located on U.S. Highway 63, Clear Lake is a 60 minute drive from the Minneapolis/St. Paul Metro area. Clear Lake is home to approximately 1,080 residents.

Clear Lake can provide numerous recreational opportunities. The centerpiece of these opportunities is our 260 acre village park.
